In total, the CRRSAA authorizes \$81.88 billion in support for education, in addition to the \$30.75 billion expeditiously provided last spring through the Coronavirus Aid, Recovery, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, Public Law 116-136.

## **Cares Act/HEERF II Policy** Effective January 1, 2021

Based on the Cares Act/HEERF II, additional aid is available for our students that can demonstrate need.

### Requirements of Eligibility For None FAFSA Recipients:

- Students are required to be enrolled in one of DSI Academy's programs as of January 1, 2021
- Students are required to, accurately and honestly, complete the questionnaire for eligibility that is provided by the DSI Academy.

### Eligibility for PELL Grant recipients:

- Expected Financial Contribution \$0-\$2500 – Eligible for \$1500
- Expected Financial Contribution \$2501-\$4000 – Eligible for \$1000
- Expected Financial Contribution \$4001-\$5578 – Eligible for \$750
- Expected Financial Contribution \$5579-\$10000 – Eligible for \$500

DSI Academy may consider extra disbursements depending on individual financial circumstances and case-by-case situations.

The student may give consent to DSI Academy to use the funds toward tuition owed to the school.
